  - e. Act on any other legally allowed or required BOR matters.

- 18. Proceed to hear objections, if any, and if proper notice/waivers given, unless scheduled for another date.
- 19. Consider/act on scheduling additional BOR date(s)
- 20. Adjourn (to a future date if necessary)
